Minutes of Meeting of the Southeast Iowa Regional Riverboat Commission (SIRRC) January 21, 2025 Microsoft Team Meeting

CALL TO ORDER/INTRODUCTIONS

The meeting was called to order at 4:52 p.m. CST by President Justin Pieper.

<u>COMMENTS FROM AUDIENCE</u>: Comments from the audience were requested and no comments were provided. Dave Schwarz was recognized as this being his last meeting and a discussion occurred concerning his prospects and years of service.

PRIOR MEETING MINUTES:

The minutes of October 22, 2024 were approved. The first motion was made by Joe Steil. The motion was seconded by Terry Johnson. A roll call vote was held and the minutes were unanimously approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

A. Jason Hutcheson, Treasurer provided an update and review of the financial affairs of SIRRC. Relevant to the same, find attached Exhibit "A". A general discussion occurred concerning the financial reports.

A motion was made approving A of the Treasurer's Report above by Terry Johnson and was seconded by Chuck Kempker to accept the financial report. A roll call was made and A of the Treasurer's Report above was unanimously approved.

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CATFISH BEND CASINOS LLC REPORT:

Rob Higgins, General Manager for Catfish Bend Casino was present and made a report to the Commission concerning the following:

- 1. A general review of operations of the Casino for 2024 and the first part of January 2025 occurred. Rob reported that the holiday promotions and revenue was up. A discussion occurred and no action was taken by the Board.
- 2. Higgins reviewed the Catfish Bend Holiday promotions and complimented, with appreciation, marketing staff for the Casino.
- 3. Higgins reviewed the current projects at the Casino including construction and remodel updates of the Casino. Rob reported that the lobby bar is now open, the coffee shop continues to be remodeled, the high limit room in the Casino is near completion, the Pullman Lounge will soon be demolished and a general discussion of the remaining timelines, as well as projects planned to occur and in process at the Casino, occurred.
- 4. Iowa Racing and Gaming. Rob reported that the Annual Gaming Day at the Iowa Capitol is approaching. Rob will attend. It is anticipated that an issue before the Iowa Legislature remains concerning the licensing moratorium. Rob also reported that on March 5/6 a licensing renewal meeting will be held with Prairie Meadows. President Justin Pieper will attend on behalf of SIRRC.
- 5. Questions from the floor. Discussion occurred concerning the predictions and a general discussion of anticipated Legislative action in the current Legislative session.

The Commission took no action.

ADDITIONAL ISSUES THE BOARD ADDRESSED AT THE MEETING

- A. With Dave Schwarz's departure, Kerry Klepfer will join the Board as Dave Schwarz's replacement.
- B. License Renewals for Commissioners. Four Commissioners, Justin Pieper, Steve Link, Chuck Kempker, and Jason Hutchinson, licenses are subject to renew. They were reminded of the January 31 deadline to complete this process. Each Commission indicated that they would timely file their renewals.
- C. Gaming License for Catfish Bend has been notarized, signed, and submitted to the regulatory authorities.

- D. QSO Operations Agreement with Catfish Bend has now been duly signed and a copy of the executed agreement is in the corporate files of SIRRC.
- E. 2024 SIRRC Audit is completed. It was distributed on December 23, 2024 to the Board for their review.
- F. Beneficial Ownership Information filing was discussed. No action was taken.
- G. Charitable Impact Fund and Annual Contribution Summary. See attached "C". A general discussion occurred concerning questions from the Commission.
- H. Approval of Service Partner Agreements. A general discussion occurred concerning the continued employment of Menke & Company and Cray Law Firm. A motion was made by Brian Bross, seconded by Terry Johnson to continue the partnership agreements for the continued 2025 calendar year. It was unanimously approved.
- I. Election of Officers. A general discussion occurred and President Justin Pieper recommended continuing the slate of officers as follows:
 - i. President, Justin Pieper
 - ii. Vice President, Kirk Brandenberger
 - iii. Treasurer, Justin Hutcheson
 - iv. Secretary, Terry Johnson

A motion was made by Chuck Kempker, seconded by Bryan Bross to approve the continuation of the present slate of officers. It was unanimously approved.
